PREPARE DIGITAL PHOTOS FOR PRINTING

DIGITAL MEDIA

You can bring your digital images in for us to print on either a CD, memory card or other digital media. Files must be in either TIFF or JPEG format as we do not support camera raw files. Please note that your camera will have the files prepared correctly for printing, providing that you are not shooting raw images.

FILE REQUIREMENTS

- TIFF files can contain no Adobe Photoshop channels.
- JPEG files should be saved at maximum quality. (10-12 in Adobe Photoshop)
- All images should have a minimum of 300 DPI (PPI) at actual size for optimum quality.
- All images must be in an RGB colour space and 8-bit colour.
- All images should be sized and cropped to the requested print size. We will use our best judgement when cropping images that are not sized correctly.

IMAGE EDITING

SIZE PROPORTIONS

This diagram compares the proportions of a few common photo sizes and shows why it is important to crop your own images. Cropping your own images ensures that you will get the results you were expecting.
